Weigh-ins will be from 7:45 am to 9 am. Wrestling will start at or around 10:00 am. All wrestling and period lengths will be in accordance with current USAW wrestling rules. Seeding will be done by blind draw, but matches will be paired using double elimination line brackets or round robin depending upon number of entrants. Awards will be given to the top three finishers in each class. During weigh-ins, all competitors will be inspected for skin rashes. Wrestlers with skin rashes will not be allowed to compete unless they have a <u>current</u> doctor's excuse saying they are under treatment, are not contagious as of a specified date and are cleared to wrestle; tournament officials reserve the right to refuse entry to questionable cases.

A current USA Wrestling card <u>MUST</u> be shown at registration. Cards cannot be purchased at this event. Cards must be purchased in advance at http://www.usawmembership.com/

Wrestling will be preceded by a rules and wrestling clinic.
