EVENT PHILOSOPHY:

With COVID disrupting the traditional youth season in New York State, Journeyman Wrestling has stepped in to create a state championship tournament.

The event that everyone wants to see! The tournament is a 6U, 8U, 10U, 12U, and 14U division competition.

Meeting Expectations: Please understand that this format will be different than, perhaps, what you're accustomed to. It is not the NY State NYWAY or USAW State championships, therefore it will be different. Consider it a hybrid (mix between) of what you've been accustomed to. Our single purpose is to create a viable avenue for athletes to showcase their talent in a proven setting, and have fun doing so.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

REMEMBER Age Group is determined by the wrestlers age on March 31, 2021

If you register and do not pay, you'll be removed from the system and not considered registered.

RULES:

NFHS Folkstyle Rules

- Bout Length: 1:30, 1:30, 1:30 periods
- Please be aware that if a weight class is under 9 competitors, we reserve the right to use round robin, or modified round robin bracketing. This style of bracketing may be used in other age divisions, but not others. We will use this type of bracketing as we see fit.

• Weights:

- NYS 6U: 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 75 (**Madison weights for this division**)
- NYS 8U: 43, 45, 49, 53, 56, 62, 70, 85
- NYS 10U: 50, 54, 57, 60, 64, 68, 72, 78, 85, 94, 105, 120
- NYS 12U: 58, 64, 68, 71, 75, 79, 83, 87, 93, 99, 109, 118, 136, 150
- NYS 14U: 72, 78, 84, 88, 93, 98, 103, 107, 111, 115, 120, 126, 131, 137, 150, 165

Select the appropriate weight from the start! That said, you will have until March 13, 2021 to change your weight.

- *If you need to change your weight after the March 13, 2021 deadline, you can request consideration via email. If you move your weight without notification after this time period, you stand the risk of being removed from the event.*
- *There will be a \$40 "weight change" fee assessed if the change is accommodated.*

Registration & Entry Fee:

- All entry forms must be completed online and meet March 28, 2021 deadline or before the event is sold out. Maximum of 450 competitors.
- Once you've received a written pre-approval and a four-digit code from Journeyman Wrestling to wrestle in the event, you'll be directed to register online via www.journeymanwrestling.com
- Once you've been approved, you are expected to have finished the registration at that moment (**register and pay**), otherwise the process starts over and eligibility is reassessed. Please reach out only when you're ready to actually enroll.
- **Registration is \$60**
- THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS ONCE YOU REGISTER
- Spectator Fee: \$20 (good for April 1, 2021)
Spectators are allowed, but limited to parents and immediate family. This is not a traditional stadium, so seating is non-conventional: bleachers, chairs, etc.
- **Coach's Pass/Fee:** \$50 (good for April 1, 2021 - youth tournament only), purchased at the door.

ITINERARY:

- Wednesday evening, March 31, 2021, Spooky Nook Sports (for GPS: 75 Champ Blvd., Manheim, PA or Spooky Nook Sports, 2913 Spooky Nook Rd., Manheim, PA) 5:30-7:30 PM.
- There is no weight allowance
- You will be assigned a specific weigh-in time between the posted times below
5:30-6:30 PM: NYS 6U, NYS 8U, NYS 10U
6:30-7:30 PM: NYS 6U, NYS 12, NYS 14U

It is imperative that you honor your assigned time.

SCHEDULE:

Wrestling: begins Thursday April 1 at 9:00 AM on 14 mats.

AWARDS: Singlets provided by RUDIS (finalists), medals to 1-6 place.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are allowed, but limited to parents and immediate family. This is not a traditional stadium, so seating is non-conventional: bleachers, chairs, etc.

ALERT: Journeymen Wrestling will follow be enforcing Pennsylvania's COVID PROTOCOLS for the Tournament:

- Everyone attending the sporting event, including coaches, officials, athletes, staff, and spectators, age 2 and older, must wear face coverings (masks or face shields) unless they are outdoors and can consistently maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Individuals who fall under an exception listed in Section 3 of Universal Face Covering Order, are not required to wear a face covering.
- Athletes are not required to wear face coverings while actively engaged in workouts and competition that prevent the wearing of face coverings, but must wear face coverings when on the sidelines, in the dugout, etc. and anytime 6 feet of social distancing is not possible.
- Spectators may attend sporting events, but count towards the statewide large gathering limitations as outlined in the maximum occupancy calculator, and must follow the Universal Face Covering Order and social-distancing guidance when arriving, attending, and departing the event.
- The community, league, or team must educate all athletes, staff and families about the symptoms of COVID-19 and when to stay home. Athletes also should be educated on proper hand washing and sanitizing.
- Coaching staff, officials and other adult personnel must wear face coverings (masks or face shields) at all times, unless doing so jeopardizes their health.
- Coaches and athletes must maintain appropriate social distancing at all times possible, including in the field of play, locker rooms, sidelines, dugouts, benches, and workout areas. During down time, athletes, coaches, and officials should not congregate.
- Coaches and athletic staff must screen and monitor athletes for symptoms prior to and during games and practices. If individuals participating in sporting activities show symptoms, have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, or are sick, they must be sent home.
- Avoid shaking hands, fist bumps, or high fives before, during or after games and practices. Limit unnecessary physical contact with teammates, other athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- If multiple games are to be held at the same facility, adequate time shall be scheduled between contests to allow for facilities to be cleaned and disinfected, and to minimize interaction between athletes. Sports complexes with multiple fields may operate simultaneous games or practices on fields within a complex only if social distancing can be maintained. Each individual game or practice at a complex must adhere to the gathering-occupancy limits using the maximum occupancy calculator.
- Concession stands or other food must adhere to the Guidance for Businesses in the Restaurant Industry.

Releasor acknowledges and fully understands that each participant in any Journeymen Athletics, LLC sanction event, meet practice or activity, including Releasor, will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent, temporary, total or partial disability, disfigurement, paralysis and any other losses to person or property, including death, and that severe social and economic losses may result not only from Releasor's own actions, inactions or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions or negligence of others notwithstanding the rules of play or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used.
